As part of the “One Scouts Canada” announcement earlier this year, it was identified that two teams have been established to work together and in support of the organization’s Strategic Goals – the Field Services Team and the Field Operations Team.

The Field Services Team continues to provide leadership and implementation support for the program and people pillars of our Strategic Plan. (The Council Key 3, along with Area Key 3s and the Council Service Team in support of our Groups and Sections).
